Features and Benefits

- **Simple wiring**

System is easy to install with simple wiring, keeping installation costs low

- **Simple operation**

Patients or residents will have an efficient way to communicate with staff

All incoming calls are controlled directly from the nurse master station

Calls can be answered with push-to-talk operation or with the handset for privacy

- **LED and call tone indicators**

The urgency level of each call is indicated by the LED lights and differentiating tones

- **Corridor and zone indicators**

Staff can quickly see where a call is generated by using the corridor and zone indicator lights

- **Remote area duty station**

Alerts staff of an incoming call when they are away from the nurse master station

Users do not need to worry about desk clutter with this sleek, compact nurse master station

- **Spill-resistant cover on master**

The protective membrane on the nurse master station prolongs its lifespan

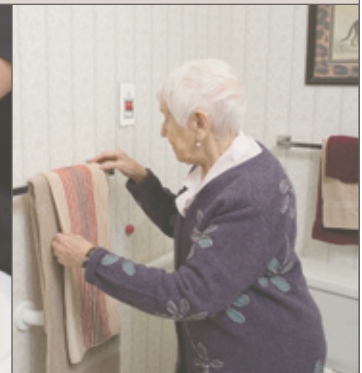
Save time and sustain high-quality care with this communication system. The master station is an efficient way for caregivers to visualize and prioritize the urgency of multiple calls, while providing the convenience of staff-to-patient or staff-to-resident communication.



Make sure personnel are never out of touch, even in remote areas. With the optional duty station, nurses and staff will be alerted of an incoming call while away from the master station. The differentiating call signal will indicate if the call is routine or urgent.



Bedside call buttons ensure patients and residents have vital access to their nursing staff. With a simple push of the button, a routine call is sent to the master station, indicating assistance is needed. An unplugged cord activates an urgent call at the master, indicating a serious situation.



Along with bedside call buttons, urgent call pull cords provide a way for patients or residents to instantly reach staff in an emergency. The urgent call pull cord is ideal for common bathroom locations or in rooms where critical care is needed more often.

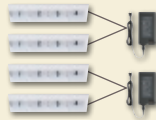
Duty Station
Install 1 per system

NHR-SP
Duty Station
• Ideal for break rooms, hallways, or locations without a master station
• Alerts staff when a master station receives a call
• Urgent calls override routine calls
• Tone off button
• Flush mount
• Fits 2-gang box

Indicator Light
Install up to 4 per system



NHR-3A-4
4-Zone Call Indicator Light
(max. 4 - requires 1 PS-2420UL per 2)
• Indicates the hallway/corridor where a call is made
• Wall or ceiling mount

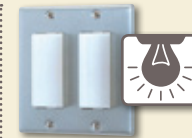


Patient/Resident Stations

Mix and match up to 80 total sub stations - use call button(s), pull cord(s), and a corridor light per sub



NHR-4A/A
LED Corridor Light
(red and amber LEDs)
• Indicates the room where a call is made
• Amber light indicates a routine call and red light indicates an urgent call
• Flush mount
• Fits 1-gang box
4-3/4" H 2-3/4" W 1-1/2" D



NHR-3TS
Dual Corridor Light Sub Station
(required for NHR-7A if NH-1SA/A or NH-2SA/A are not used)
• Allows the urgent call pull cord to be used without the need for a bedside station
• Indicates where an urgent call has been made in a common area location
• Stainless steel faceplate
• Flush mount
• Fits 2-gang box

NHR-7A
Urgent Call Pull Cord
• Activates urgent call at master
• Connects to sub stations for use in common bathrooms (NHR-3TS) or patient/resident rooms (NH-1SA/A or NH-2SA/A)
• Flush mount
• Fits 1-gang box

NH-1SA/A
Single-Jack Bedside Sub Station
• One jack for bedside call button
• Cancel button
• Hands-free communication
• Flush mount
• Fits 2-gang box

NH-2SA/A
Dual-Jack Bedside Sub Station
• Two jacks for bedside call buttons
• Cancel button
• Hands-free communication
• Flush mount
• Fits 2-gang box

NHR-8C
Bedside Call Button
(with 7" cord)
• Activates routine call at master
• Cord-out activates urgent call at master

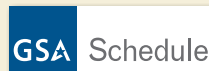
